We look forward to welcoming all your teams to the beautiful Rimini/Riccione region of Italy in June for the XIth WKC World Karate Championships.



TRANSPORT

ROADS AND HIGHWAY CONNECTIONS:

From the north, the fastest way to get to Rimini is to head south on the A14 motorway and exit at Rimini North. From Bologna use the A1 motorway from Milan, from Turin and Piacenza use the A21 motorway and from Brenner and Verona use the A22.

From the south, the fastest way to get to Rimini is head north on the A14 motorway, and exit at Rimini South. From Bologna use the A1 motorway that also comes up from Rome and Florence, and the E45 highway that runs from south to north from the cities of Rome and Cesena. From the city of Cesena use the SS 16 Adriatic highway.

AIRPORT CONNECTIONS:

Use Bologna (Guglielmo Marconi), Forlì (L. Ridolfi), Rimini (Federico Fellini), Venice (Marco Polo), Ancona (Aeroporto delle Marche). All of these aiports are connected with the most important Italian and European cities by scheduled and charter flight.

RAILWAYS CONNECTIONS:

Rimini is easily reached by train stops at Rimini railway station which is on the Bologna Ancona line.
